

LONG DIVISION

Divide Step by Step

Objective: Divide step by step: divide, multiply, subtract, then bring down the next digit.

INSTRUCTION For each digit, divide, multiply, subtract, then bring down the next digit. Write the quotient on top of the line.

EXAMPLE Follow the steps to solve it.

$$\begin{array}{r}
 880 \\
 7 \overline{) 6166} \\
 \underline{-56} \\
 56 \\
 \underline{-56} \\
 06 \\
 \underline{-0} \\
 6
 \end{array}$$

- 1 $61 \div 7 = 8$; $8 \times 7 = 56$; $61 - 56 = 5$. Bring down the 6.
- 2 $56 \div 7 = 8$; $8 \times 7 = 56$; $56 - 56 = 0$. Bring down the 6.
- 3 $6 \div 7 = 0$; $0 \times 7 = 0$; $6 - 0 = 6$.

$$6166 \div 7 = 880 \text{ R } 6$$
