Count 11 to 15 • Model

Objective: *A teen number is one ten and some ones.*

DO THIS Fill the ten frame, then add the ones.

DISCOVER Ten and some more.

EXAMPLE



and



$$10 + 1 = 11$$

1 ten and 1 ones

BUILD A TEEN NUMBER Write the teen number.

1



and



$$10 + 5 = \square$$

2



and



$$10 + 4 = \square$$

3



and



$$10 + 2 = \square$$

A teen number is: one ten and some ones

TEACHER EDITION

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$$10 + 1 = 11$$

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BUILD A TEEN NUMBER Write the teen number.

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and



$$10 + 5 = \underline{15}$$

2



and



$$10 + 4 = \underline{14}$$

3



and



$$10 + 2 = \underline{12}$$

TEACHER NOTES Answer key & guidance

Answers: see page
Common error: A model that does not match the labelled number.

Strategy: Have the child build the model before recording.
Prompt: "Show me how you know."
