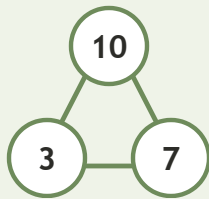

TWO WAYS Add and subtract the same parts.

1 $4 + \square = 10$
 $10 - 4 = \square$

2 $2 + \square = 10$
 $10 - 2 = \square$

3 $9 + \square = 10$
 $10 - 9 = \square$

4 $7 + \square = 10$
 $10 - 7 = \square$

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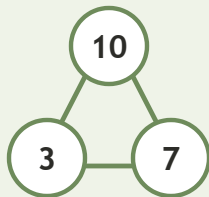
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EXAMPLE



TWO WAYS Add and subtract the same parts.

1 $4 + \underline{6} = 10$
 $10 - 4 = \underline{6}$

2 $2 + \underline{8} = 10$
 $10 - 2 = \underline{8}$

3 $9 + \underline{1} = 10$
 $10 - 9 = \underline{1}$

4 $7 + \underline{3} = 10$
 $10 - 7 = \underline{3}$
