

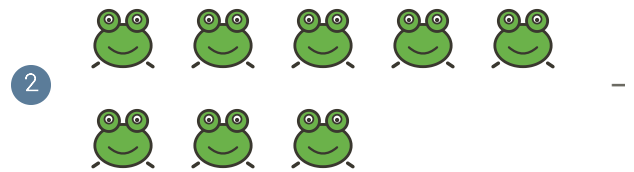
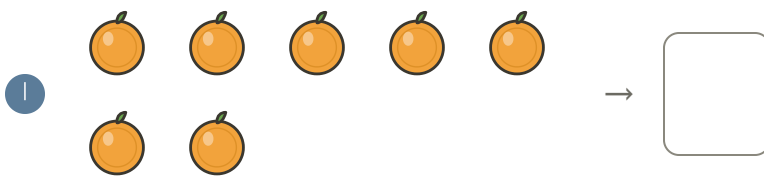

1 • COUNT Write how many.



2 • ADD Find the sum.

1 $1 + 1 = \square$

3 • SUBTRACT Find what is left.

1 $6 - 4 = \square$

4 • STORY Read and solve.

5 • PROVE Solve and check.

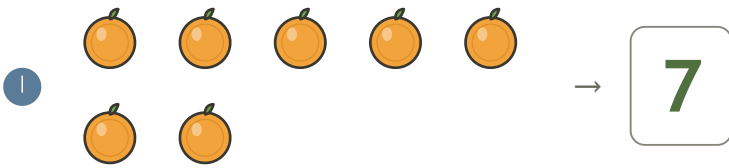
