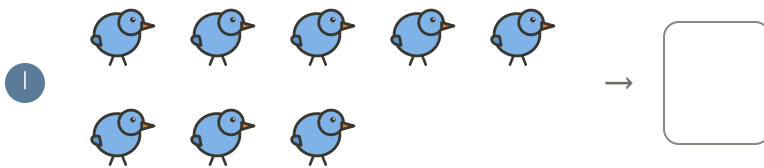

DO THIS Solve each one. Use any strategy you know.

1 • COUNT Write how many.



2 • ADD Find the sum.

1 $4 + 5 = \square$

3 • SUBTRACT Find what is left.

1 $5 - 1 = \square$

4 • STORY Read and solve.

Eli had 5 stickers. He gave away 4. How many stickers are left?

5 • PROVE Solve and check.

EXAMPLE

$$5 - 1 = \underline{4}$$

$$1 + \underline{4} = 5$$

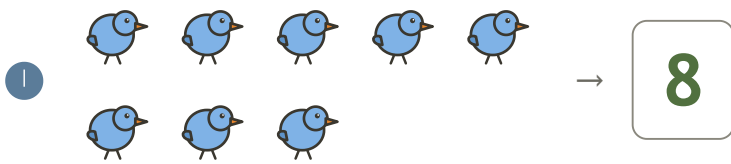

TEACHER NOTES Answer key & guidance

Answers: see page
 Common error: Choosing an operation before understanding the situation.

Strategy: Read each situation aloud; let the child interpret first.
 Prompt: "Show me how you know."
