Count 11 to 15 • Connect

Objective: *Connect teen numbers to ten and ones.*

**DO THIS** Write the teen number for ten and some ones.

**CONNECT** Ten plus ones makes a teen number.

**EXAMPLE**



**TEN AND ONES** Write the teen number.

1  $10 + 3 = \square$   
1 ten and 3 ones

2  $10 + 1 = \square$   
1 ten and 1 ones

3  $10 + 5 = \square$   
1 ten and 5 ones

4  $10 + 4 = \square$   
1 ten and 4 ones

A teen number is:  one ten  and some ones

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Objective: *Connect teen numbers to ten and ones.*

**DO THIS** Write the teen number for ten and some ones.

**CONNECT** Ten plus ones makes a teen number.

**EXAMPLE**



**TEN AND ONES** Write the teen number.

1  $10 + 3 = \underline{13}$   
1 ten and 3 ones

2  $10 + 1 = \underline{11}$   
1 ten and 1 ones

3  $10 + 5 = \underline{15}$   
1 ten and 5 ones

4  $10 + 4 = \underline{14}$   
1 ten and 4 ones

**TEACHER NOTES** Answer key & guidance

Answers: see page  
Common error: Treating the picture and the symbol as unrelated.

Strategy: Link the model to the numeral or equation aloud.  
Prompt: "Show me how you know."
