

## TEEN NUMBERS

Count 16 to 20 • Model

Objective: *A teen number is one ten and some ones.*

**DO THIS** Fill the ten frame, then add the ones.

**DISCOVER** Ten and some more.

**EXAMPLE**



and



$$10 + 9 = 19$$

1 ten and 9 ones

**BUILD A TEEN NUMBER** Write the teen number.

1



and



$$10 + 8 = \square$$

2



and



$$10 + 9 = \square$$

3



and



$$10 + 5 = \square$$

A teen number is:  one ten  and some ones

## TEEN NUMBERS

Count 16 to 20 • Model

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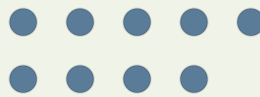
**DO THIS** Fill the ten frame, then add the ones.

**DISCOVER** Ten and some more.

**EXAMPLE**



and



$$10 + 9 = 19$$

1 ten and 9 ones

**BUILD A TEEN NUMBER** Write the teen number.

1



and



$$10 + 8 = \underline{18}$$

2



and



$$10 + 9 = \underline{19}$$

3



and



$$10 + 5 = \underline{15}$$

**TEACHER NOTES** Answer key & guidance

Answers: see page  
Common error: A model that does not match the labelled number.

Strategy: Have the child build the model before recording.  
Prompt: "Show me how you know."
