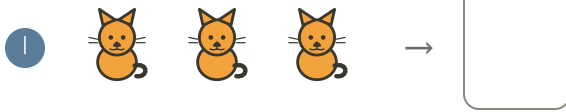

1 • COUNT Write how many.



2 • ADD Find the sum.

1 $2 + 3 = \square$

3 • SUBTRACT Find what is left.

1 $3 - 2 = \square$

4 • STORY Read and solve.

5 • PROVE Solve and check.

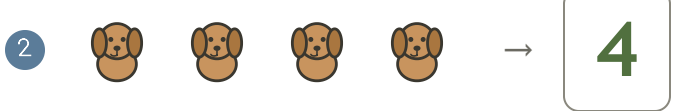
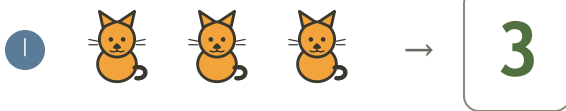

Common error: Choosing an operation before understanding the situation.
