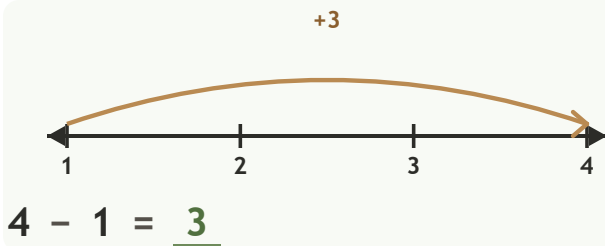

Subtraction as Separating • Strategy

Objective: *Count Up to subtract.*

DO THIS From 1 up to 4.

STRATEGY: COUNT UP From 1 up to 4.



YOUR TURN Count Up to subtract.

1 $5 - 4 = \square$

2 $2 - 1 = \square$

3 $3 - 2 = \square$

4 $3 - 1 = \square$

5 $4 - 2 = \square$

6 $4 - 3 = \square$

To subtract I: took away counted up found the part



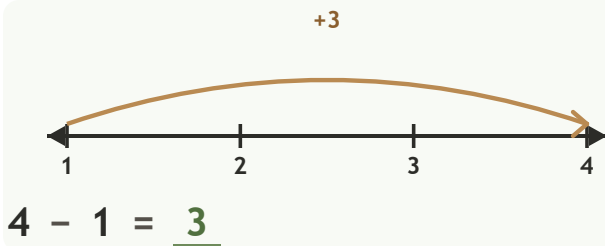
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1 $5 - 4 = \underline{1}$

2 $2 - 1 = \underline{1}$

3 $3 - 2 = \underline{1}$

4 $3 - 1 = \underline{2}$

5 $4 - 2 = \underline{2}$

6 $4 - 3 = \underline{1}$
