Addition as Joining • Discover

Objective: *Join two groups to make a whole.*

DO THIS Put the groups together. Count them all.

DISCOVER Joining makes more.

EXAMPLE



Join the groups.

$$2 + 1 = \underline{3}$$

JOIN AND COUNT How many?

1



+



$$1 + 8 = \square$$

2



$$6 + 1 = \square$$

3



$$4 + 3 = \square$$

4



$$3 + 5 = \square$$

To add 1: counted all counted on made ten

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Objective: *Join two groups to make a whole.*

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EXAMPLE



Join the groups.

$$2 + 1 = \underline{3}$$

JOIN AND COUNT How many?

1

$$1 + 8 = \underline{9}$$

2



$$6 + 1 = \underline{7}$$

3



$$4 + 3 = \underline{7}$$

4



$$3 + 5 = \underline{8}$$
