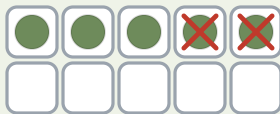
Addition and Subtraction Families • Model

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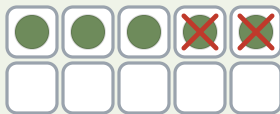

Answers: see page
Common error: A model that does not match the labelled number.

Strategy: Have the child build the model before recording.
Prompt: "Show me how you know."
