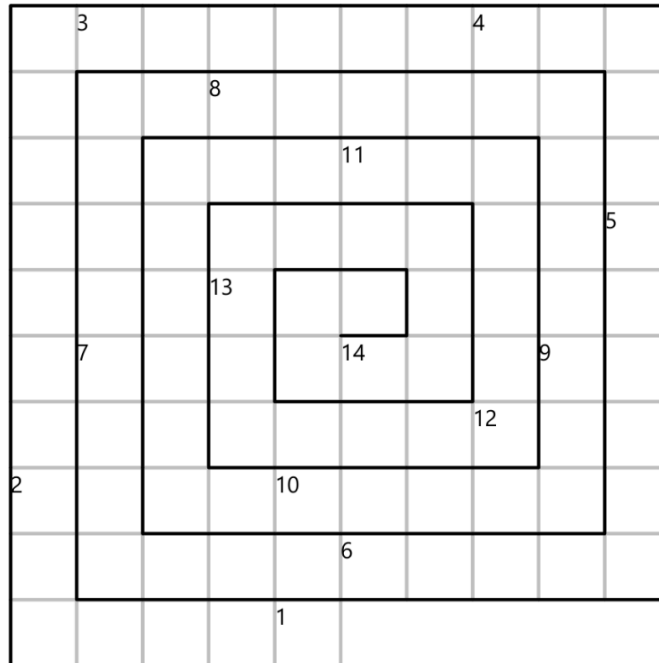


Spiral Crossword
