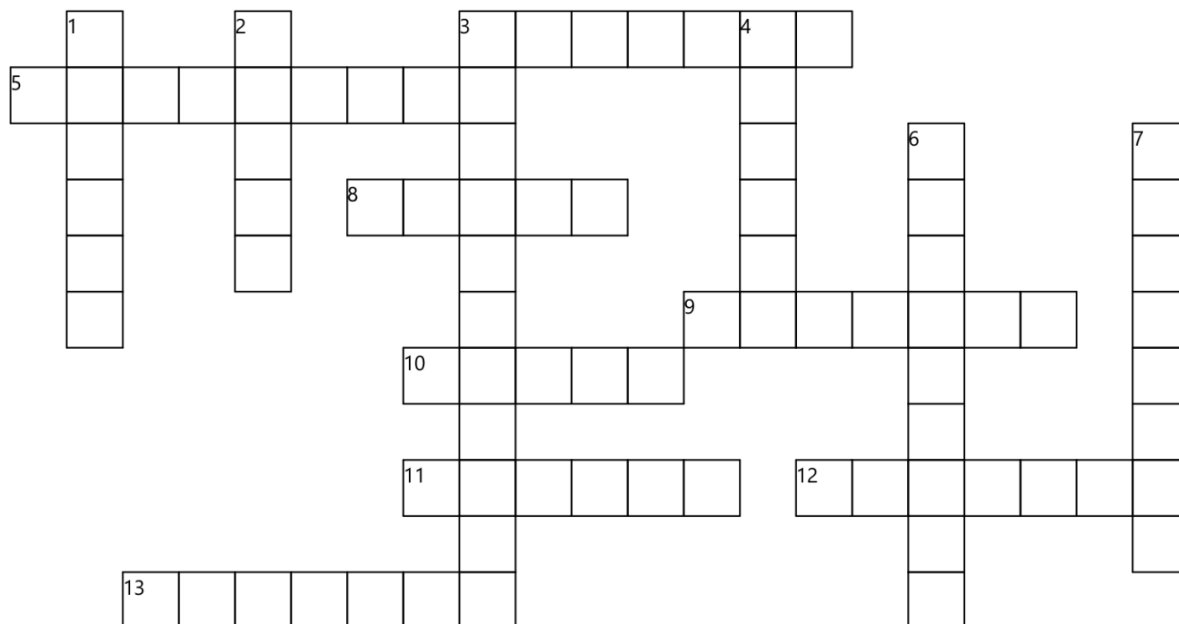


Crossword
